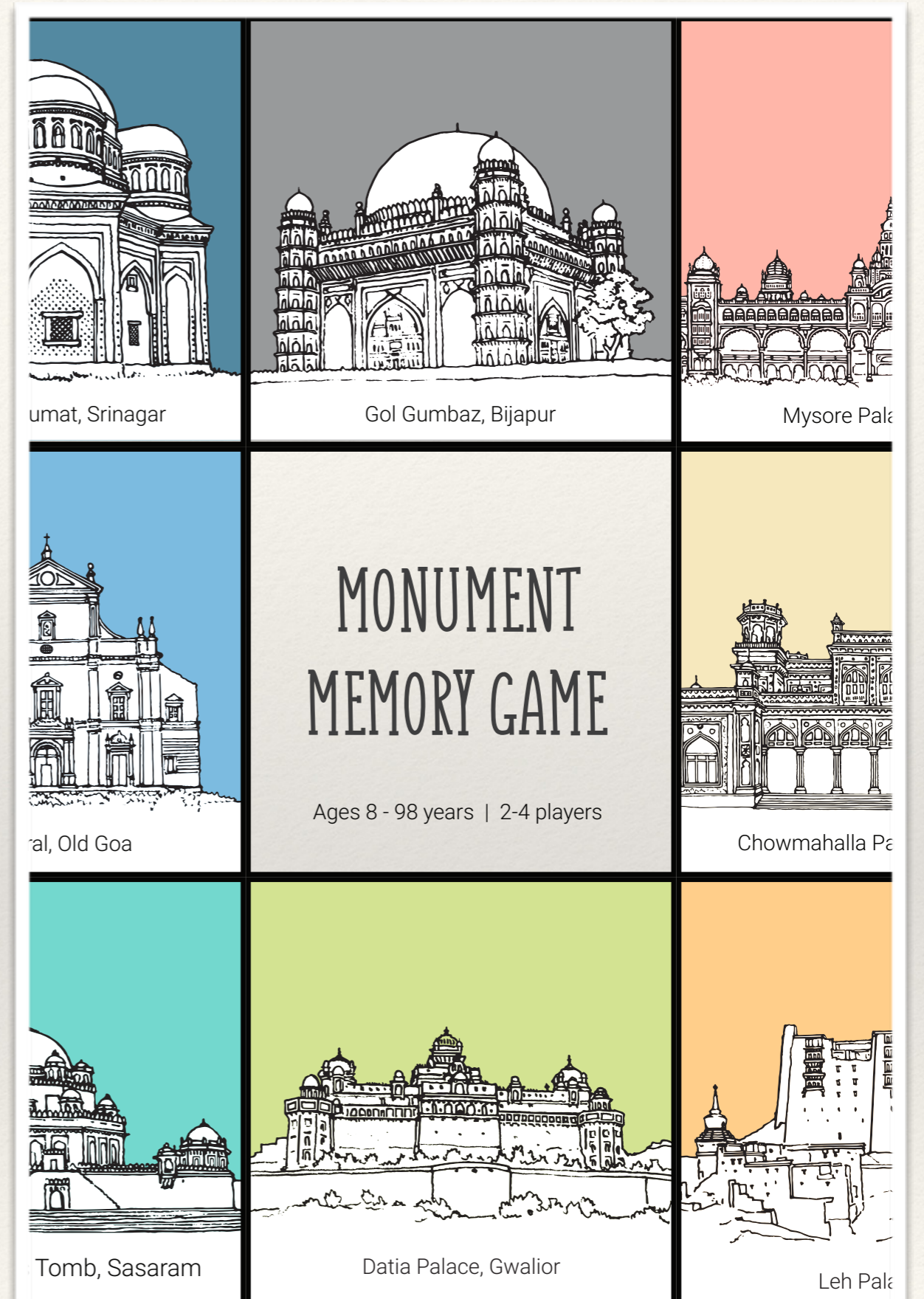

Monument Memory Game

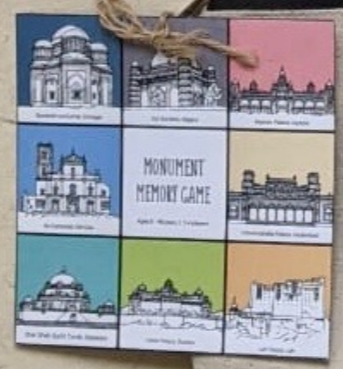
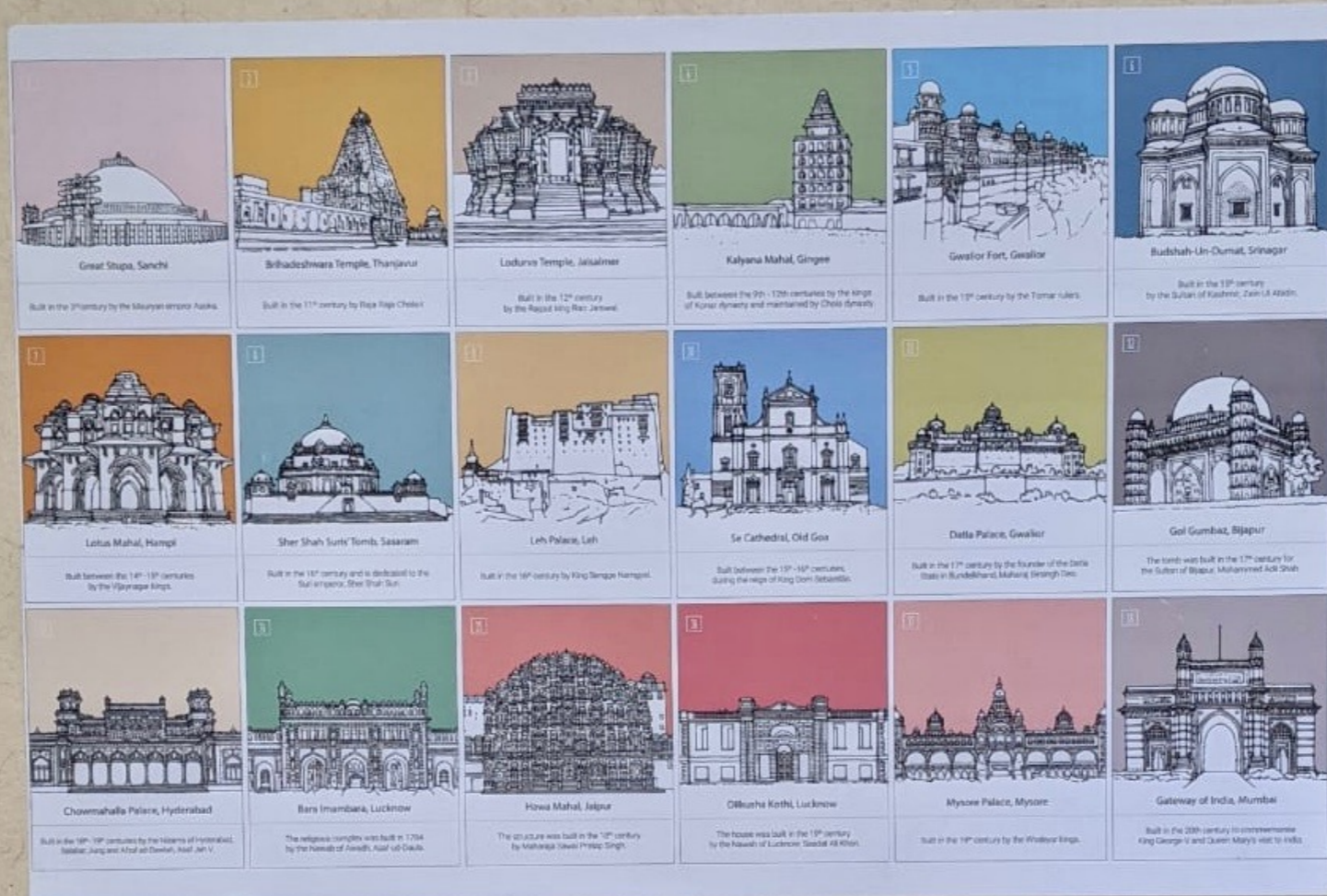

Great Stupa, Sanchi

Built in the 3rd century by the Mauryan emperor Asoka.



Brihadeshwara Temple, Thanjavur

Built in the 11th century by Raja Raja Chola I



Lodurva Temple, Jaisalmer

Built in the 12th century by the Rajput king Rao Jaisalwal.



Kalyana Mahal, Gingee

Built between the 9th - 12th centuries by the kings of Konar dynasty and maintained by Chola dynasty.



Gwalior Fort, Gwalior

Built in the 15th century by the Tomar rulers.



Budshah-Un-Dumat, Srinagar

Built in the 15th century by the Sultan of Kashmir, Zain-Ul-Abidin.



Lotus Mahal, Hampi

Built between the 14th -15th centuries by the Vijaynagar kings.



Sher Shah Suri's Tomb, Sasaram

Built in the 16th century and is dedicated to the Suri emperor, Sher Shah Suri.



Leh Palace, Leh

Built in the 16th century by King Sengge Namgyal



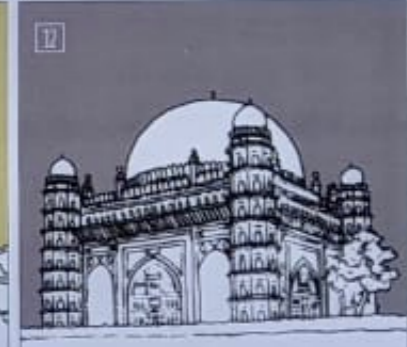
Se Cathedral, Old Goa

Built between the 15th -16th centuries, during the reign of King Dom Sebastião.



Dattia Palace, Gwalior

Built in the 17th century by the founder of the Dattia State in Bundelkhand, Maharaj Birsingh Deo.



Gol Gumbaz, Bijapur

The tomb was built in the 17th century for the Sultan of Bijapur, Mohammed Adil Shah.



Chowmahalla Palace, Hyderabad

Built in the 18th-19th centuries by the Nizams of Hyderabad, Salabat Jung and Afzal-ud-Dawlah, Asaf Jah V.



Bara Imambara, Lucknow

The religious complex was built in 1764 by the Nawab of Awadh, Asaf-ud-Daula.



Hawa Mahal, Jaipur

The structure was built in the 18th century by Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh.



Dilkusha Kothi, Lucknow

The house was built in the 19th century by the Nawab of Lucknow, Saadat Ali Khan.



Mysore Palace, Mysore

Built in the 19th century by the Wodeyar kings.



Gateway of India, Mumbai

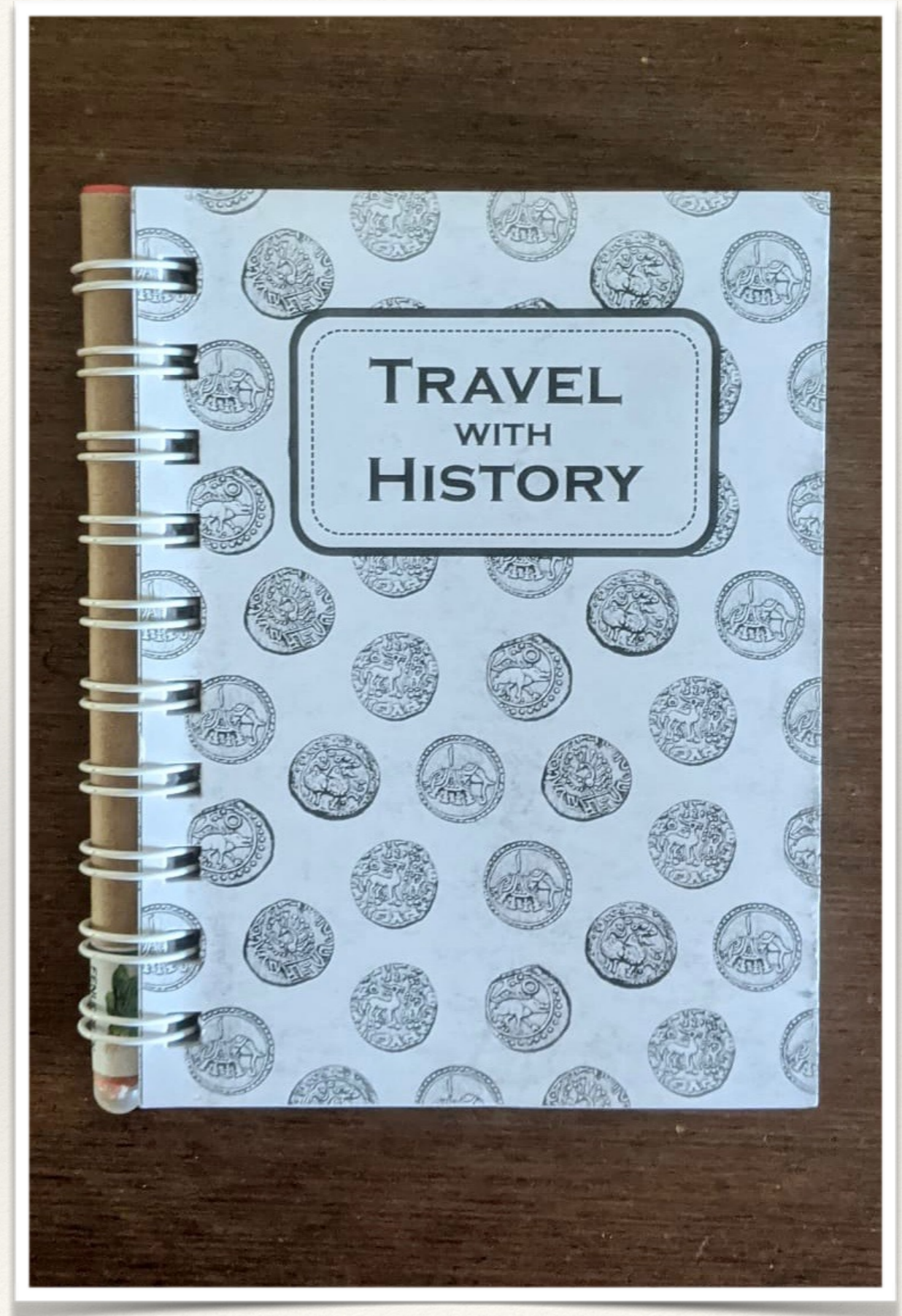
Built in the 20th century to commemorate King George V and Queen Mary's visit to India.

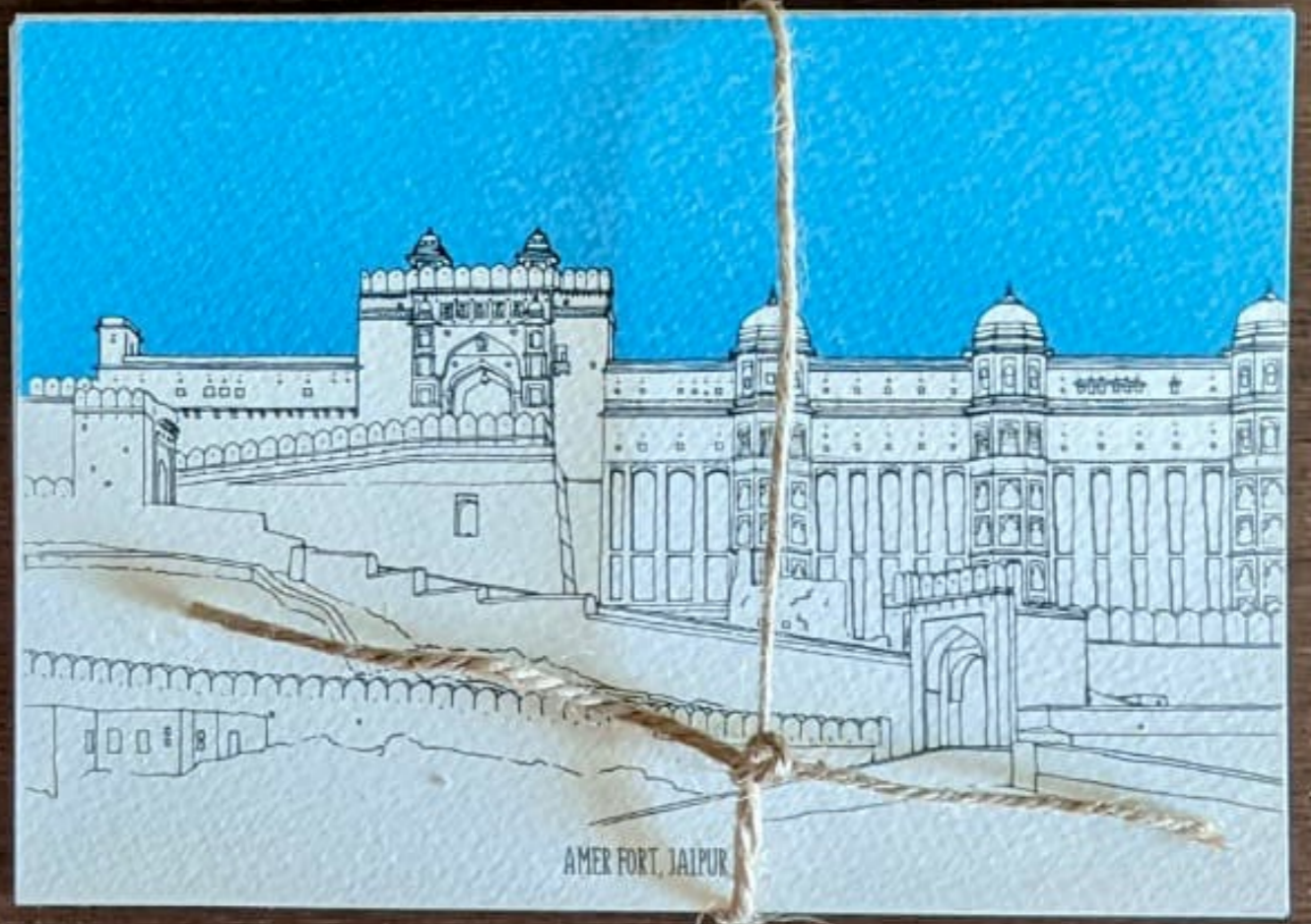
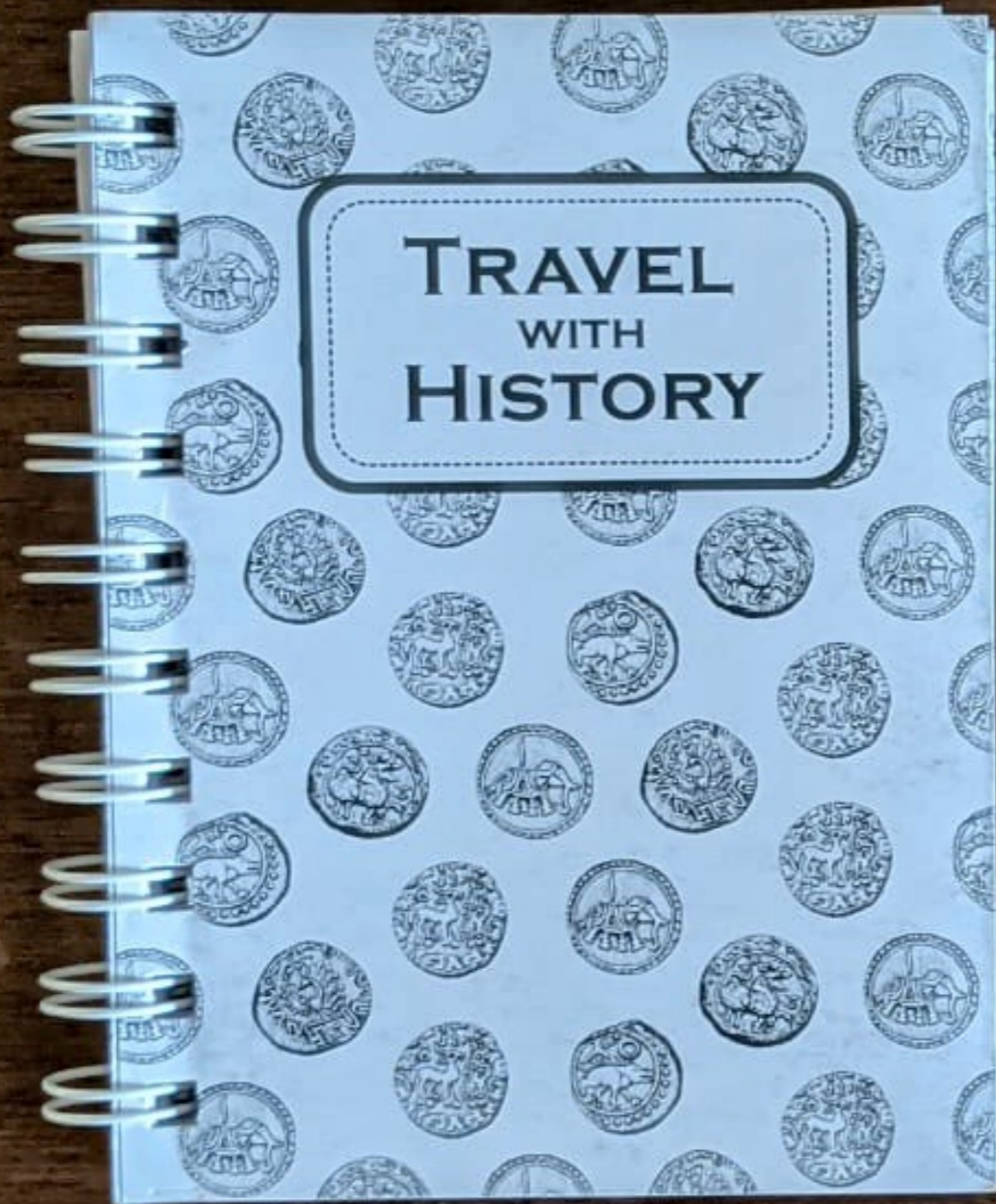

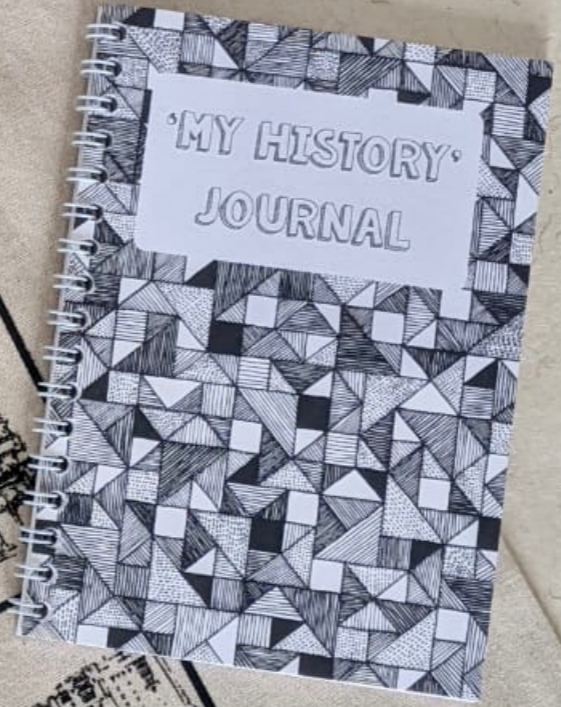
